Prime Sheep - 398 Forward

Meat still hard to come by but never the less some very good lambs presented this week, and a full compliment of buyers. The SQQ was up on last week at 308.33 P/KG and the overall was 303.74 P/KG. M Baylis sold fed Texels at 334 P/KG for 47 Kg or £157. Just ahead of R Randall & Son with 48.50 Kg Continentals at 328 P/KG or £159. Handy weight Beltex from P+E Roads sold to 327 P/KG for 36.50 or £119.50. Leach farm sold their usual quality to £165 for 53 Kg ahead of Messer Anderson at £164 for 56 Kg Texels.

Store Sheep - 196 Forward

A very mixed bunch of store lambs. The best of the stores £101-£118, Medium keep was £90-£100, with longer keepers £40-£70.

Ewes - 272 Forward

The ewe average of £100.40 included a very poor and lean show of ewes. Best continentals sold between £160-£173. Best Mules were £130-£140, even very lean £60-£70. More ewes needed to meet demand.
