M/s Hinton sold their homebred Charolais x British Blue steers at £2000.00 and pens at £1695.00 and £1660.00. M/s R W Harrison & Sons sold their homebred Limousin x for £1875.00 and £1725.00 for four. Charollais from the same farm sold to £1695.00 all 18/20 months. M/s CR & HS Quartly sold their run of pure Limousin steers 17 months to £1570.00 and £1500.00 both for six.

The best of the Aberdeen Angus came from Paul Empson, with a pair of steers at 23 months and £1700.00. M/s Connell Partners took £1540.0 and £1525.00. M/s M & J Franklin, Cuckfield sold their Angus and British Blue to £1515.00.

M/s D & N Farming took £1500.00 for their 8-month Limousin x steer. M/s J & C Hinton, Syresham topped the heifer trade with a Charolais x British Blue, 26 months at £1680.00 others from the same farm sold at £1480.00. M/s Quartly sold pure Limousin at £1600.00 and £1405.00 while Connell Partners topped the Aberdeen Angus x at £1480.00 followed by M/s Franklin at £1400.00.
