A reasonably strong trade today for all but a few younger cattle.

Aberdeen Angus topped the day with a run from John Flanagan selling his home bred steers to £1705 at 17 months with dairy X from the same farm selling to £1660 and £1590.

Blue Friesians from Bridget Lady Silsoe sold to £1550 and Montbeliarde X to £1450. M/S P.T. Harris + Son sold there Simmental X steers 18 months at £1475 only topped by John Flanagan at £1510.

South Devon X from Dick Cottrell Farming sold to £1350 at 15 months.

John Flanagan topped the heifers with a single Aberdeen Angus X Simmental at £1600 and Simmental X at the same farm £1460 at 18 months. Bridget Lady Silsoe sold er British Blue X Dairy at £1550. Blonde X from M/S P.T Harris + Son sold at £1280.

In calf Aberdeen Angus 2nd Calvers sold to £1300 from John Lee.

One of the nicest shows of store lambs we have had in a while. Nearly 350 lambs sold to average £92.26. The shortest keepers traded £100 to £116 for JH Tapping + Sons lovely bred Texels. Medium keep lambs looked very well, sold this week regularly trading & either of £95. A lot of very lean and long keep lambs forward which sold from £65-£81 regularly.
