### Prime Sheep -494 Forward

Fat trade nationally on the up with Thame following suit and leaving us with an SQQ of 306.45 p/kg and an overall of 299.08 p/kg, smart lambs today all 315 p/kg and above. Topped by Messer G Curtis & Son at 333 p/kg (£130) for Beltex X at 39 kg. Messer's D & B Cox was just behind with fed continentals at 331 p/kg (£145.50) for 44 kg. Meat heavies all £150 plus, today the weight really played dividend. David Weston had 67 Kg fed continentals at £187 with his 56 Kg at £181 and 57 Kg at £172.50 the same as Mr J Wallington for his 58 Kg.

# Store Sheep - 169 Forward

A very varied yard of stores and a very varied trade. K.W Slade sold quality Charollais to £126 for a big pen full. Medium keepers were £85-£100 with short keep all £100 plus. Some big pens of longer keepers looked very dear at £80 plus.

#### Ewes -153 Forward
