Clean Cattle (486)

Fewer placed in August after bumper numbers in July. Producers had in their minds to have yards empty pre-harvest. As numbers tighten, up go prices with commercial R grades finishing the month at over 500p/kg. Several weeks saw 5p/kg increases – a lift of 15-20p/kg through the month.

- Please order replacement ear tags allowing plenty of time for them to arrive before your stock goes.
- Please check breed & sex on passports
- All stock must have two ear tags on leaving the farm if they only
 have one and they lose one that equals none and that equals the bin
- Please ensure stock is ready to load before lorries arrive it is not fair to have drivers waiting making them late for next collections.
- To comply with the Welfare of Animals in Transport Act any unsound stock will require a vet certificate before loading.
- Young bulls must be 12 months + one day of age.

With cereal prices low, grass disappearing and pleasing returns for finished beast's producers are housing cattle earlier than normal. This will pay dividends in terms of performance and speed up finishing. Cattle coming in with interna; fat always perform quicker having not lost it walking around for a mouthful of grass until October. Commercial R grades finish the month at 500-505p/kg. Aberdeen Angus 510-515p/kg, Young Bulls 495-500p/kg and Beef Shorthorns 517p/kg.

Pleasing to see cereal prices exceeding 500/kg again, long may it continue. Processors reporting good sales but a lot of top sides and silversides in store – this will probably be sold on promotion later on in the year. Last year trade dropped rapidly in July and lifted in September, trade is lifting from a much higher level this year – will we see 530p/kg? Young bulls coming to an end – we will now see a few over 16 months come forward which have not got fit before the deadline. Grass cattle are extremely short this year.

Producers should keep an eye on cattle ages with a 10p/kg deduction on OTM's now imposed – if cattle are fit under 30 months don't let them slip over!
