Yet another strong trade for our Native cattle day, kindly sponsored by County Insurance. Steers sold to £2535 for Limousin X from T Hutt & Son at 25 months. Others from the same farm sold at £2380. Mike Bovingdon topped the Aberdeen Angus X at £2440 and £2420 at 23 months. Dylan Isaac followed at £2230 for a Dairy X. M/S Connell took £2100 suckler bred, while M/S PC & RW White sold to £2010. M/S Croxton Park Estate sold their run of Beef Shorthorn steers to £2120 for a pen of 8 at 15 months & £1970 for 4 at 13 months.

Charolais X Dairy steers from Philip Misselbrook sold for £1970 at 28 months. Simmental from M/S Masters topped at £2100 23 months. £1960 for outwintered 24 months from Mr C Hill while David Alder sold his 12 months at £1950 – Aberdeen Angus from Newbottle Estate sold to £1870 at 12 months. Friesian steers from Dylan Isaac sold at £1910.

M/S EW & JE Masters topped the heifers at £2300 and £2280 for homebred Simmentals. M/S Connell Partners took £2140 for Limousin X followed R Newell at £2120. Limousin X Dairy from Dylan Isaac sold for £2060 for 9. Charolais X from M/S Hutt topped at £2060, while Fisher Street Farms sold at £1695 at 13 months. Beef Shorthorn heifers from Croxton Park Estate topped at £1740 at 16 months.

Feeding Cows topped at £2990 for Aberdeen Angus X from Mike Bovingdon who sold others to £2090 for Sussex to £2160. Church Farms sold their Herefords at £2340 while M/S Jeffs took £2000 for a South Devon. An Aberdeen Angus Feeding Bull from Church Farm sold for £2350.

Cows and calves topped at £2290 for Aberdeen Angus X.
