Paul Bates, Maidford stole the day with his run of Aberdeen Angus X British Blue Steers & Heifers. Steers topping at £2360, £2300, £2260 and £2250. Ron Varney sold his Limousin X at £2300. Aberdeen Angus X Dairy from R Hyett sold to £2140. Chris Hill Partnership sold their Simmental Steers at £2100.

Heifers topped at £2180 for a 29-month Simmental X from Ditch End Farm, Paul Bates took £2120, £2110 and £1900 for his Aberdeen Angus X British Blue at 19 months. Dave Waters sold at £1965 and Newbottle Estate £1900. 16 months British Blue X suckled from RL & JM Priddle sold at £1750. 12-month Blue X from Mrs Rawding sold at £1540.
