Demand just as strong for the closer finishing cattle especially the Aberdeen Angus X. 14–16-month lesser bred cattle were a little less money on the week. George Eaton topped the day with first time of selling homebred store cattle at £2310 for an Aberdeen Angus X Simmental steer at 18 months. Others from the same farm sold to £2280 & £2250. Oxenford Farm LTD sold their Aberdeen Angus X South Devon steers to £2270, £2195, £2190 & £2170. B S & T Tuckwell sold their Aberdeen Angus X to £2100 at 17 months & Beef Shorthorns to £2020 at 19 months. Hereford X Dairy from John Wallington topped at £1940 while JW Elliott & Son sold Aberdeen Angus X Dairy to £1940 & a run of 12 to £1300. A single Friesian steer 25 months from the same farm at £1900.

George Eaton topped the heifer trade with a trio of Aberdeen Angus X Simmental at £2160, Noel Doran took £2100 and BS & T Tuckwell £2010 along with Oxenford Farms. South Devons from Oxenford Farms sold to £2070. Beef Shorthorns from Hodson Farmers sold to £1960. 12-month Aberdeen Angus X Dairy from M/S Elliott sold to £1125 for a pen of 9.
