Our annual Xmas store cattle sale was a huge success for the last Friday of the year with a sale total of £780,994.

Strong cattle sold to £2305 for a homebred Limousin steer from M/S Tombs & Son, who sold others to £2080 & £2040. Noel Doran topped the Aberdeen Angus at £2260 at 23 months, followed by M/S R M Parsons & Son at £2220 at 16 months. Barton Farms took £2140 & Vicky Bell £2100. Andrew Fowles sold his pen of Hereford X at £2170 followed by Andrew Woollatt at £2100. Graham Sellars pen of Simmental X steers 21 months sold at £1980. Younger steers topped at £2000 for 11-month Limousin steer from M/S Tombs, M/S Parsons sold Aberdeen Angus X at £1800 11 months. M R Deeley & Son £1700 11 months, also 10 months from PM & JE Batstone & Son sold at £1600.

M/S Tombs topped the heifer trade with their 16-month Limousin X at £2200 followed at £2020 & £1980. Paul Bates took £2160 for his Aberdeen Angus X. Vicky Bell took £2010 & Noel Doran £2000. Hereford X from Andrew Fowles sold to £1910. Friesian X from D G Dyer sold at £1880. Young 9-month Aberdeen Angus heifers from G D Swerling & Son sold to £1440, M/S Batstone took £1390, £1380 for Aberdeen Angus X. A pair of South Devon in calf cows from M/S CJ & S Page sold for £2580.

Feeding cows sold to £2570 for a Limousin X from M/S M M Whidborne & Son. Blonde X from the same farm sold at £2390. A run of Simmentals from G D Swerling sold for £2180, £2170.

Feeding Bulls sold to £2650 for a Beef Shorthorn, £2450 for Aberdeen Angus & £1770 for a Simmental.
