A more difficult days trading today, the quality of cattle overall was not as good, coupled with a slight drop in the beef trade not helping. Philip Misselbrook topped the steers at £2200 and £2000 for homebred Aberdeen Angus X. M/s Kemp followed at £1960 and M/s Rand Contracting Ltd £1910 for a pen of 7 at 14 months. M/s F C Lester & Son sold their pen of pure Limousin steers 12 months at £1990.

Philip Misselbrook took £1980 for his Beef Shorthorn x 20 months while M/s Langford took £1805 for a pair of grazey pure Hereford with 13 months from M/s Bovingdon selling at £1635. 13-month Stabiliser x from M/s Grainge sold to £1640.

M/s F C Lester & Son sold their homebred Limousin heifers 12 months at £1900 for a pen of four. Clive Winslow took £1895 for his 28-month Aberdeen Angus x while M/s Connell Partnership sold Herefords to £1805 and British Blue x dairy to £1692.

Yearling Aberdeen Angus x sold to £1480 from M/s McLaren, £1470 Alder Farming and £1460 Rand Contracting.

British Blue x dairy feeding cows sold to £1645 and £1525 from M/s Deeley.
