Trade remains firm for the stronger stores close to finishing, but the 10-12 months sorts were generally less on the day. M/S McDonnell topped the steer trade with home bred Aberdeen Angus X 19 months at £2270 and £2230. John Tapping took £2250 for a smart Angus X Continental while Pure Aberdeen Angus from Godwin Farm Partnership sold at £2240 and £2220, 16 months from Rob Lawrence took £2030. Dairy X Aberdeen Angus from M/S Rinder LTD sold to £1980 at 25 months. M/S Ray Farm Partnership sold 16-month British Blue X at £1930 and £1910 at 16 months. M/S T H Hutt & Sons sold their 14 months steers to £1630. Followed by M/S Thornton at £1570at 13 months. D J Knight sold Beef Shorthorn homebred steers for £1920 at 17 months.

M/S T H Hutt & Sons topped the heifers at £1940 for Blue X Dairy 25 months. Mr R Hyett sold his Aberdeen Angus X Dairy 27 months at £1940 and 31820. M/S Rinder sold Angus X Dairy to £1800 at 25 months. Limousin X from John Tapping sold £1870. Beef Shorthorn X from D J Knight 19 months sold to £1780 and £1700.

Feeding Cows sold to £1500 for a Hereford from M Cooke. Cows and Calves topped at £3280 for a Limousin Cow and Calf from Micheal McDermott, with others to £3180 and Simmental X from David Knight £2270.
