An excellent day's trading for our annual Suckled Calf Sale which was topped by M/S RS & GDH Alderman with his single Aberdeen Angus X steer at 9 months to £1825. Messer's C & A Morley sold their Run of Charolais X to £1820, £1810 & £1800, taking the prize for the best pen of Charolais or Charolais X. D M Surman & Son sold their run of Aberdeen Angus X to £1800 & £1748, J B Stevens & Son topped at £1735. A J Breakspear sold their British Blue X steers to £1700. A run of Limousin X South Devons from Stuart Summers sold to £1500.

12–15-month steers topped at £2005 for 14-month Aberdeen Angus X from M/S Alderman, Delafield Bros took £2000 for Charolais X & M/S Breakspear £1935 for British Blue X.

M/S C & A Morley also won the Charolais heifer class, taking £1710 & £1680 for pens of 5 & 7 at 8 months. Aberdeen Angus X from M/S Stevens sold at £1460. M/S Sabine sold Limousin X to £1420 followed by Limousin X South Devon from Stuart Summers at £1380. Nick Jones sold a pen of Charolais heifers 18 months at £1930, while Simmental X from M/S Alderman sold at £1620 & Aberdeen Angus X at £1545 (13 months).

In calf cows to £1870 for Hereford X from D Pope with her heifer calf selling for £830. Charolais Cows with young calves from Nick Jones sold to £2530& £2420. Aberdeen Angus feeding cows sold to £1580.
