An increased entry this week met a very strong trade for all on offer and a new market record price for a feeding cow of £3195 for the first of a pair of British Blues from A Phillips, Ashampstead who also took £2980 for the second and £2450 for a Limousin cow.

Val Crawley topped both the steer and heifer section with two housed Aberdeen Angus X 23 months, selling for £2040 (steers) & £1900 (heifers). Noel Doran broke the £2000 barrier for his steer at £2018 followed by P Blundell & Son at £2010. Alder Farming sold his Simmental X steer 18 months at £1910 followed by M/S R & R Hutt with South Devons at £1905. British Blue X Dairy from A.S Coles & Son sold to £1890 for a pen of 5.

12-month Aberdeen Angus X British Blue steers from M/S Deeley & Son topped at £1380 while 11 month outwintered from M/S Burborough sold at £1185. Noel Doran took second highest heifer price at £1870 for his homebred Aberdeen Angus. M/S Tapping took £1775 and the run of 22 from Barton Farms sold to £1735. Blue X Dairy from M/S Coles sold to £1850 at 23 months with a pair at £1660. M/S Tapping also sold Limousin X at £1640, while South Devons from Dick Cottrell Farming topped at £1540. Aberdeen Angus 12 months from M R Deeley & Son sold to £1200 for a pen of 10.

A Phillips, Ashampstead sold his pedigree British Blue feeding cows to £3195 and £2980 exceeding his April 2024 price £3090.
