Steers to £2105 Heifers to £1970

Trade remains very strong, but the strength of the cattle was lacking this week.

Aberdeen Angus X led the field topping at £2105 for a single homebred steer by the Glympton Bull, from David Haynes. Barton Farms sold to £1948 for their trio, £1880 a single and £1868 for a pen of 5. Dave Alder took £1820 and L & L Colbourne £1745 for Angus X Dairy. Hereford X from J & C Hinton sold to £1800. While British blue X Dairy sold to £1720 at 16 months from M/S Colbourne. 17 Month Simmental X from M/S Alder Farming sold to £1510. M/S Lindley Hall Farms sold their run of 10-month-old Hereford X Dairy steers at £1130 for a pen of 10.

Bartons farms sold a pen of British Blue X Dairy to £1970 for a single and £1940 for a pen of 5 at 28 months. M/S Colbourne took £1600 at 17 months and Havenhurst Farm £1490. J & C Hinton sold their homebred Charolais X to £1790 for a pair at 22 months and £1590 for three. The best of the Aberdeen Angus came from M/S B & D Haynes, taking £1585 for 4. D J Alder Farming sold their Simmental X at £1580 at 18 months. Dodwell Partnership sold their Hereford heifers 11 months at £1070.

Feeding Cows topped at £1754 for a Simmental X from Mrs M L Honour, Aberdeen Angus X to £1660 from Dodwell Partnership.
