Steers to £2450 Heifers to £2060 Feeding cows to £1980

Another strong trade today for everything from suckled calves to native bred steers. Aberdeen Angus X topped the day from H H Wadland & Sons 18 months at £2450 & £2395. Sir Richard Sutton LTD sold 18 months at £2370, while 24-month Angus X Dairy from R J Taylor sold to £2320 for 8. M/S Wadland topped the Herefords at £2380 while Hereford X Dairy from G R Crawley sold at £2285 followed by M/S Taylor at £2280. M/S E & R Ashby sold Simmental X to £2220. A few suckled calves & 12-month steers sold to £1870 at 12 months for Aberdeen Angus X Charolais. M/S Field Place Farm sold 7-month steers at £1260.

M/S PC Stovold & Son topped the heifer trade with their Aberdeen Angus at £2060. M/S Ashby took £2040 for their Simmental X Heifer, while Limousin X from Giles Philp & Partners sold to £1840 along with M/S J H Tapping & Son. British Blue X Dairy from RG, JM & R Thornton sold to a top of £1570 at 13 months. Hereford X Dairy from Kingston Hill Farm sold at £1505. 12-month Aberdeen Angus X Charolais from K J Wolfe Farms sold at £1370 while 7-month Aberdeen Angus from Field Place Farms sold for £1045.

OTM cattle sold to £1700 for Limousin X from M/S PW & ME Jones and the same for Aberdeen Angus from M/S Wainwright both steers. M/S Jones went on to take £1720 for their heifers.

Feeding Cows sold to £1980 for a Limousin X & Herefords sold to £1750.
