Trade continues to improve each week for a market average of £1562.72 and a top of £2300 for a pen of 3 Aberdeen Angus and a single Hereford steer 22 months from Alden Farms. Other pens from the same farm sold at £2290 and £2250. Noel Doran sold his Aberdeen Angus to £2230 and £2220. M/S M & J Franklin & Son took £1970 for Aberdeen Angus X Dairy. 11-month Limousin X steers from Tilley Farming Partnership, Cranleigh topped at £1990 for a trio with others at £2800, £1790 and £1760. Out wintered Charolais X from LA & VS Evans topped at £1970 and £1860. Simmental X 11 month from A Wise & Son sold to £1760.

Aberdeen Angus topped the heifers from M/S S.H Beaman & Son at £1940, closely followed by Noel Doran at £1920 Blue X Friesians topped at £1850 at 17 months from M & J Franklin. M/S T.H Hutt & Son followed at £1830. Rob Lawrence took £1690 for his Beef Shorthorn 17 months and £1640. M/S Tilley sold their Single Limousin X British Blue 12 months at £1630.
