A run of aged Hereford steers 28-29 months from Lee Valley topped the section at £2440 and £2400, Black and whites sold to £2220 from the same farm. M/S Marsh Hill Farm LTD sold their run of Aberdeen Angus X to £2400 and £2310. M/S J H Tapping sold a run of Limousin X to £2120. M/S L & L Colbourne sold two pens of homebred 10 months to £2045 for seven and £2010 for 11 months.

Dairy X Charolais from M/S Harper & Hopper topped at £2070 at 20 months. And Limousin X £1980. Out wintered Stabilisers X sold to £1860 for a pen of 8 homebred from J Grainge.

Ray Newell, Denham sold his pen of homebred outwintered Limousin heifers to £2520. John Tapping took £2150 for Limousin X, while the best of the Aberdeen Angus X Dairy sold to £1990 from Harper & Hopper who sold British Blue X to £1980. Mike Dickens sold his Simmental X Dairy to £1930 followed by M/S Harper and Hopper at £1920. Charolais X sold to £1920 from the same farm. M/S Tilley Farming sold their Blue X suckle bred to £1640 at 13 months and Limousin X to £1610 at 12 months.

A Hereford stock bull sold for £2500 for further feeding.
