Trade continues to be strong for all sizes of cattle especially the 12–15-month sorts. Now selling close to £2000 per head. Older steers 19-26 months topped at £2300 for a homebred Limousin X from G.W Bush & Son. Robert Tandy equalled for British Blue X Dairy, also selling another pen at £2230. Philip Misslebrook sold his Aberdeen Angus X to £2240 and £2200. Hereford X Dairy from Lee Valley Country Park sold to £2100 at 27 months and £1995 for 13 months out of the suckler herd.

Heifers topped at £2105 for 5 British Blue X Dairy from Robert Tandy who also sold at £2070 and £2040. Connell Partners sold Aberdeen Angus X to £2100 followed by John Tapping at £2070 and Clive Winslow at £2015. M/S G. W Bush & Son sold Limousin X heifers 20 months at £1980 and £1900. Hereford X Dairy from Lee Valley sold £1890 at 29 months.

A run of overage heifers topped at £2790 for 5 Herefords at 48 months from R Wiles. K Poulter sold his Charolais heifers 37 months at £2500.

Hereford X feeding cows sold to £2360 from M/S Fowles, while a 24-month Aberdeen Angus bull from Prue McDonald settled at £2580.
