Trade in general a little easier as beef prices start to reduce each week and the grass fails to grow. The few stronger cattle sold well to £2470 for an Aberdeen Angus X steer 26 months from Marsh hill Farm. Phillip Misselbrook sold 17 months at £2110 and Hogshaw Hill Farm £2090. Ray Newell sold his homebred Limousin steers off the grass at £2310 (21 Months), While N.P Jones sold pure Charolais 15 months at £2060 and £1880 at 14 months. Tom Hodges took £1680 for his pen of 12-month Parthenaise X. Rand Contracting sold his pen of Aberdeen Angus 14 months at £1600.

Nick Jones sold two pens of pure Charolais heifers 13 and 14 months to £2260 for 6 and £2080 14 months. Marsh Hill Farm sold Aberdeen Angus X to £1950, while Stabiliser X from M/S P J & J Waters sold to £1780. Pure Limousin from W J & M Marsh LTD sold at £1775 and Charolais X from M/S Hazell took £1740. M/S Barkers Farm sold their Aberdeen Angus X Dairy to £1200 at 11 months.

Feeding cows sold to £1870 from M/S Hodges for shapely Parthenaise and £1675 for Charolais X from David Waters. An older Simmental X cow with her heifer calf sold for £1940 from Rodney Howe.
