Felix McDaid topped the steers with an Aberdeen Angus and Beef Shorthorn steer aged 14 months at £2460. British Blue x Dairy from M/s K & S Walker sold to £1940, while grazing Beef Shorthorns from David Knight sold at £1910.

Michael Ashby followed with his pen at £1900 and went on to sell Saler x Beef Shorthorns to £1910 for a pen of six and £1800 at 14 months old.

Hereford x Dairy from M/s K Walker sold to £1910.

Mr A Inwood sold his run of Pure Charolais heifers at 24 and 26 months old to £2580 and £2000.

Hereford x Dairy topped at £1830 from M/s Walker.

Noel Doran sold his homebred Aberdeen Angus heifers aged 23 months for £1800 followed by P Blundell & Sons at £1770.

A run of Limousin x Feeding Cows from C & J May topped at £2680 and £2280 while M/s Church Farm took £2170 for a Hereford.

A Jersey bull sold for £1510.
