Numbers are still hard to find which is helping keep the store trade up. A marvellous run of Parthenaise, Limousin and British Blue home bred steers from Alan Saw topping at £2720 with others at £2680, £2600 and £2470. British blue X from Kerr and Sons sold to £2210, and Limousin X £2100. A F Pinkerton and Son sold Aberdeen Angus X British Blue 15 months at £1800. Rob Lawrence took £1700 for his 17-month Aberdeen Angus and £1605 for Beef Shorthorn.

Alan Saw topped the heifer trade for his Aberdeen Angus X Parthenaise at £2500 and others to £2240. A run of Lincoln Red heifers 27 months topped at £1940 and £1890 from Lee House Farm. Limousin X Heifers from M/S Kerr and Sons topped at £1800. Overaged Lincoln Red heifers topped at £2490 and £2470 from Lee House Farm. While Limousin X from RE Wyatt took £1780.

Feeding cows sold to £2160 for Shorthorn X from Mr P Grace. Hereford X cows and young calves sold to £2260.
