A lovely run of Aberdeen Angus X British Blue from David Wright, Waddesdon topped the Steer section at £2100 at 17 months. Other pens from the same farm sold to £2000 and £1850. John Flanagan sold to £1875, while Aberdeen Angus X Dairy sold to £2030 at 20 months. Will Browning sold his run to £1810. Older pure Herefords from Newton Farms sold to £2080 and £1850. Hereford x Dairy topped at £1800 both from M/S Bramble and Browning. Rob Lawrence sold his Simmental X to £1865 and £1760.

Malmeswood Farm, stoke Poges topped the heifers and the day with a 22 months Aberdeen Angus at £2305 Phillip Misselbrook sold to £1990, G Bramble & Son £1925 and David Wright £1900. J.Jellis & Son sold a pair of Limousin heifers 23 months to £2120 and Hereford X Dairy to £1780. Simmental X from John Flanagan sold to £1610.
