Simmental steers from Ron Varney sold at £1890.11-month Limousin X from M/S Bush sold at £1440 while 8-month Aberdeen Angus from Godwin Farm Partnership sold at £1300 and £1240.

M/S A S Harman LTD sold their homebred Charolais heifers 27 months at £2410 and £1825 at 17 months. M/S Bush sold their Limousin X17 months at £2140. Aberdeen Angus X sold to £1940 from H & A Crocker. Blue X dairy sold to £1920 & £1880 from M/S White. Homebred Blonde X from M/S Alderman topped at £1870. M/S A S Harman LTD sold 11-month Charolais at £1540.
