A marvellous start to 2026 topping at £2550 for a pair of British Blue X Dairy steers 24 months from M/S Harper & Hopper, who went on to sell other British Blue X to £2360, £2340 & £2180. Aberdeen Angus X Dairy from the same farm topped at £2460, £2360 & £2190. L & L Colbourne from Newdigate Surrey took £2320 for Aberdeen Angus X at 16 months. Limousin X from the same Vendor sold to £2200. Beef Shorthorn X 19 months from M/S S.H Beaman & Son sold to £1930.

This week's heifers lacked strength but still topped at £1910 for a trio of Simmental X from C D Sellar & Son. Beef Shorthorn X from M/S Beaman sold to £1880 20 months. While Rob Lawrence sold Aberdeen Angus 16 months at £1690. British Blue X Dairy from Mr M Kennealy sold to £1620 at 16 months.

Only a trio of feeding cows from Andrew Fowles topped at £2400 for a White Charolais X. Hereford X sold to £1770 & £1710.
