Steady demand again this week as abattoir prices continue to fall & little grass growth. The strongest smartest sorts still forward favour, with steers topping at £2200 for Simmental X from the Masters family who also sold at £2170 & £2080 this time for Aberdeen Angus X. Limousin hit £2090 for 14 months from PSB Livestock & £2000 for a run of 12-month steers & £1890 at 11 months. M/S Bush sold Limousins X at £1900 at 14 months. Hares & Sons sold 20-month Beef Shorthorns to £1965 & £1955 along with a pair of Aberdeen Angus X Dairy. Pure Aberdeen Angus from Huntingford Cottage Farm sold to £1885.

Mr A Phillips sold a peach of a British Blue Heifer 18 months & halter broken at £2260 to top the heifer trade. M/S GW Bush & Son sold their Limousin X at £1780 & £1700 at 16 months, followed by M/S FC Lester & Son with Pure Limousins at £1700 at 11 months. Aberdeen Angus X from Phillip Misselbrook sold to £1686 at 15 months.

A Hereford X Cow & Calf sold at £2500 from Andrew Woollatt. While a 3-year Aberdeen Angus Bull sold at £3800 from M/S Infield.
