An entry of mainly Aberdeen Angus x was led by Marcus Boniface selling 17 months to £2250.00, Nichols Farms followed at £2210.00, £2160.00 and £2150.00. E J Lacey & Son sold Aberdeen Angus x dairy at £2135.00.

British Blue x dairy from S Hall sold at £2110.00. Charollais x from John Wallington sold at £1950.00 at 22 months. Speirs Farms sold their Hereford steers 18 months at £1950.00.

Several runs of poorer heifers forward but topping at £1920.00 for Aberdeen Angus x from John Wallington. British Blue x dairy sold to £1470.00 and £1395.00 at 17 months.
