The strongest trade so far this autumn up some £100 per head on the week for all types. James Mitchell topped the day at £2400 for his pen of Aberdeen Angus X Steers 18 months. Other Angus X from M/S Alderman sold to £2340 with James Mitchell taking £2310, £2300, £2210 & £2200. M/S L & L Bovington sold their four Hereford steers homebred 19 months at £2340. M/S Mitchells pens of Simmentals 17 months sold at £2260 while M/S Beaman took £2200 for Beef Shorthorns.

Young Cattle a much stronger trade, 9 months Aberdeen Angus X British Blue homebred sold at £1660.

Heifers topped at £2280 for Simmentals from J Mitchell who also sold at £2180. M/S Alderman sold their Simmental X at £2000 along with Blonde X. Aberdeen Angus from the same farm sold at £2200 & £2120. Aberdeen Angus X dairy from Rob Davies sold at £1660.

Feeding Cows topped at £2000 from Malmswood Farm for Aberdeen Angus. Plainer cows in more demand selling to £1570 for Hereford X from S W Masters. A Hereford Cow & Angus Steer calf sold for £2260 from Duncan Mitchell.

More lambs are desperately needed to fulfil our buyer demand.

A genuine flock dispersal from Newton Lodge Farms were tremendously well sold to average £230 for a run of Lynn X flock aged ewes. With double theaves at £262 and full mouthed at £230.
