An excellent entry of strong cattle for our September exempt sale, averaging £1781.54. A total clearance saw M/S Varney, Upper Heyford top the day with four Aberdeen Angus X Simmental steers 20 months at £2375, Limousin X sold to £2180. M/S W D Hutt & Son sold British Blue X Dairy 26 months at £2300. Pure Simmental steers from C Hill Partnership sold at £2160. M/S Varney took £2150 for 18 months Angus X followed by Nicholls Farms at £2140. A single South Devon X steer from Peter Brown sold at £2130 and Hereford X at £2080. Lincoln Red steer from Nicholls Farms sold at £2010.

Lincoln Red Heifers 17 months from Nicholls Farms topped the heifer trade at £2095. Aberdeen Angus from Paul Bates sold at £2090 at 18 months, while Hereford X dairy from W D Hutt & son took £2055 with Blue X dairy from the same farm selling at £2000.
