5. The auctioneer as agent of the vendor reserves the right to bid up to the reserve price where set on any lot.
6. The auctioneer shall determine the bidding and can refuse a bid at his discretion. The auctioneer shall also reserve the right to determine the purchaser in any dispute of re offer the lot.
7. At the fall of the hammer the PURCHASER will take full responsibility for the lot. The lot may not be removed from the premises before the payment is made, (unless a prior agreement has been made with the auctioneer).
8. No lot shall be removed from the sale premises without a PASS OUT obtained from the auctioneers pay office.
9. Failure on behalf of the purchaser to pay for any lot/lots will result in a resale, any deficit or costs incurred will be the responsibility of the original purchaser.
10. Value Added Tax will be charged on all deadstock unless otherwise stated.
11. The vendor and the auctioneers as vendor's agent retain all titles in any lot until all purchase monies have been paid in full. Outstanding monies will be charged at an interest of 4% above banking lending rate.
12. The transfer of lots from the purchaser to a third party will be accepted. However, the original purchaser shall remain responsible for any non-payment.
