Steers topped at £2180 for British Blue X Dairy from AE & DG Harper & Hopper, who also took £2170, £2120 at 22 months. 18-month Simmentals from the same farm sold at £2010 & £1940. Andrew Woollatt sold pure Herefords to £2000 & £1900. M/S M & J Franklin & Son sold their Aberdeen Angus X Dairy 15 months at £1910 & a single British Blue X Dairy at £1930. M/S TR Farming sold a run of homebred Aberdeen Angus steers 13 months to £1715, £1680 & £1640.

M/S G Bramble & Son sold a single Charolais X Heifer 22 months at £2460 to top the market. Aberdeen Angus X from the same farm sold at £1900, while H.H Wadland & Son sold their Aberdeen Angus X at £1980 & Herefords at £1920. M/S Franklin took £1800 & £1760 for 16-month Aberdeen Angus X Dairy. 10-month Beef Shorthorn Heifers from M/S Blundell sold at £1200.

PD in calf Blue X Dairy heifers calving to an Aberdeen Angus bull due March onwards sold to £2440 from M/S Jellis & Son.
