A shorter entry this week at 96 head and a total for the month of 545 head, for an average of £1611.92 per head (£1296). John Kirbyshire sold his Aberdeen Angus X Steers 21 months at £2260 & £2220 to top the sale. Turley Farm Partnership sold Beef Shorthorn outwintered steers to £2240, £2150, £2135, £2130 & £2100 all at 22 months. Auctioneers pick of the day is a single Beef shorthorn outwintered steer from Penny Reid selling at £2015 at 18 months. Dick Cottrell Farming sold a run of South Devon X steers to £2180 for a pen of six at 19 months & a Limousin X South Devon 13 months at £1710. Hogshaw Hill Farm sold their outwintered Aberdeen Angus 22 months at £2100. Aberdeen Angus X British Blue steers 11 months from M R Deeley & son sold at £1600 for two pens.

Dick Cottrell Farming sold their South Devon X heifers to £1910 at 20 months & £1700 at 21 months. M/S J & C Hinton took £1850 for their 18 months Charolais X. Aged Limousin X from Mr R Wyatt topped at £1700. A run of Aberdeen Angus X British Blue heifers from M/S Deeley sold to £1580 & £1520 at 11 months.

Feeding cows topped at £1860 for an Aberdeen Angus X British Blue from M/S Deeley who also sold British Blue X dairy to £1725.
