A little less strength today and a slightly steadier trade for the older cattle, but still in line with prime cattle prices. The strongest trade today was for the 6–12-month cattle selling at prices not seen before. Amersham Haulage topped the day at £2220 for a Beef Shorthorn steer at 14 months. Aberdeen Angus X dairy 18 months from M/S Franklin sold to £2085 & £2010. Sussex X from Robert Aird topped at £1980 & Hereford X dairy from Will Browning £1950. British Blue X dairy from M/S Franklin sold to £1945.

There were very few suckler bred steers & heifers forward, younger cattle sold to £1710 for Simmentals 11 months from G D Swerling & Son and £1660 for M/S Wisson. Beef Shorthorns at 12 months from M/S Blundell took £1530. Herefords from Mr A G Woollett made £1600 at 13 months. A run of British Blue X Friesian reared steers from Greenacres Farm sold to £980 at 6 months and averaged for £943 for 21.

Mainly dairy X heifers today selling to £1970 for Aberdeen Angus X from M/S Franklin and £1920 at 18 months. R Aird sold his Sussex to £1870 at 22 months. While Simmental X from M/S Williams sold to £1820.

Richard Lacey Farming sold his Aberdeen Angus X 12 months at £1600. Others sold to £1595 for Simmentals X from M/S Wisson and £1450 for Herefords from Kingston Hill Farm. J W Thomas & Sons sold Aberdeen Angus to £1440 at 10 months. M/S Greenacres Farm sold their British Blue X Friesians 5-6 months to £910 and £900 to average £887.

Feeding Cows in short supply topping at £2290 for a Limousin X from A Woolford. A Beef Shorthorn sold to £2060 from M/S Williams.
