Once again, the long keep cattle 10-12 months were the trade of the day, short finishers were harder to sell as the reality of the prime beef price kicks in. 14-month Limousin X from M/S F G Belcher & Son topped the steers at £1945 with others to £1800. M/S C & J May sold their Beef Shorthorn X Limousin to £1940 & their Hereford X Limousin to £1850.

Felix McDaid sold unregistered Aberdeen Angus to £1790 at 13 months followed by K W Slade Farming for registered Angus X 14 months at £1720. 10-month Aberdeen Angus X from Jeff Keen sold at £1340. Nick Jones sold a Pure Charolais heifers 19 months at £2280 to top the day. Mr Cairns took £1780 for 29-month Aberdeen Angus. Followed by Hereford X Limousin at £1700 from M/S May. Rob Lawrence sold a pen of Aberdeen Angus heifers 21 months at £1685. 13-month Charolais from Nick Jones sold at £1640.
