Trade a little steadier this week as many yards are still full and feed is on the short side. Fleshed cattle sold well, leaner 'colder' sorts were less money. Aberdeen Angus X led the steers at £2285 for a pen of 3 at 18 months from M & J Franklin & Son, Ivy House Farm followed at £2250. M/S Franklin took £2235 for a pair and Ivy House Farm £2205. Ivy House Farm sold Blue X Dairy to £2280 followed by Connell Partnership £2140. Charolais X sold to £2155 and £2100 again from Ivy House Farm. South Devon from Lower Hayne Farm sold at £2020. The best of the Hereford steers came from L & L Bovingdon at £2100.

Aberdeen Angus heifers topped at £2070 from Horsham followed by Connell Partnership at £1985 and Franklin & son at £1960. British Blue X Dairy from Connell Partnership sold at £1960 and Hereford X £1940.
