A much larger entry this week as we have now entered the Blue Tongue Restriction Zone. A few buyers were missing as they are outside the zone but a few more faces appeared around the ring.

Fleshed cattle were easily sold as were the few single suckled 8-12 months. Plainer cold cattle of which there were several runs were harder to place.

The Partners Kingston Stert Farm topped the day with a single Aberdeen Angus X dairy steer at £1600 and a pen of 3 at £1520 all 24 months. Rob Lawrence sold his four homebred 14 month steers at £1500, while M&J Franklin & Son sold their pen at £1412.

M/S C D Sellar & Sons sold Simmental and Limousin X steers 21-24 Months to £1510 and £1400.

NF Hodges & Son sold home bred Parthenaise to £1510 at 18 months. A run of 12-month homebred Blonde X from M/S Alderman & Son sold to £1420 and £1350. While M/S Hodges sold 11-month Parthenaise at £1230. M/S Incley Farming took £1180 for Limousin X at 9 months.

Mr J C Kirbyshire sold his Aberdeen Angus X heifers to £1450 at 19 months as well as £1300 and £1290. Parthenaise X from M/S Hodges & Son took £1300. Mr McNally took £1290 for Hereford X followed by M/S Langford at £1100.

Mrs P McDonald sold her Aberdeen Angus 9 months to £785.

Hereford X Feeding cows sold to £1200 and Beef Shorthorns sold to £1100.
